Shining Star story of the month: A determination to bounce back

BASKETBALL NT is refocusing its role as the peak body of the sport in the Northern Territory following a Government review. Basketball NT held its annual general meeting last weekend and all interested parties were invited to an open forum where the review findings were discussed.

Outgoing Basketball NT president Pam Adam said as a result of the review, by the NT Department of Sport and Recreation, Basketball NT has implemented a "bouncing back" strategy which will take the sport in a direction that more effectively promotes a positive, supportive and stable environment for the 13,000 basketball players across the Territory.

"Basketball has around 13,000 participants in the Territory and there are over 2500 registered players but as the peak body, we need to reach those outside the urban areas and the review has strongly recommended we employ a CEO," Adam said.

"Basketball is in a healthy state in the NT. We enjoy wonderful support from Basketball Australia, but we need to expand and make some changes."

New basketball NT president Steve McGugan and his Board has the task of overseeing and implementing the recommendations including employment of a chief executive to manage the administrative tasks of the peak body.

"It's a new board and our first responsibility is to examine the proposals made in the review and the ramifications the recommendations may have on any employment and constitutional changes," McGugan said. "We've already met and put a number of committees in place to ensure the future direction of the sport is soundly based.

"Change needs to be made but we will tread carefully to ensure we get the best product in the end."



Starwin Management undertook a 10 week project with BNT to assist with the implementation of the review, also bringing 3 x Olympian Brett Maher to the Darwin to speak at the AGM event and conduct a skills session with BNT junior development squads. Starwin wishes the new board success.
